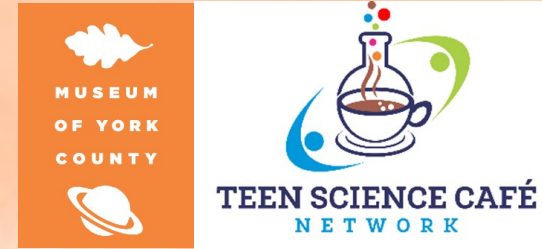
What is a Teen Science Café?

Core Design Principles
